## The Counseling Center is Open for Business

Lahai is proud to continue to provide free counselling appointments and believes that early intervention is the key to long-term wellness. Though Lahai has offered mental health counseling for 12 years, our counsellors have never had a dedicated office. That's why we are so excited to share that just last week was the first time that the counsellors were able to meet in the new space and take it all in!

Here is an initial reflection from Robert Deeble, Licensed Mental Health Counselor:

"I have been at Lahai since at least 2008 and in all those years we have never had facilities of our own. So it is with great pleasure and a dream come true that North Seattle Church has created an actual fixed site for us. I think while I had significant input in the initial design of these spaces I have mostly stepped out of the way during the actual construction and this was probably due to knowing how often construction projects go beyond their initial target dates so I had not wanted to get my hopes up. But now that it is done and really designed just as we had envisioned it I am overwhelmed with joy at its creation.

This will be a sacred place for many people in the years to come to begin to tell their stories in a safe and empathetic place. A place that clients may claim a renewed vision of hope for their lives and the sense that a strong hand of love was hidden all along in their shadows."

Directed by Robert and Supervised by Kelsey Law, the new counselling center is open for appointments while also providing training and supervision to master level students seeking licensure.
